The Southington Recreation Department is pleased to offer a variety of recreational, educational and entertaining programs for both children and adults alike. Many of our programs are limited to Southington residents only due to lack of space availability. Because the Town of Southington does not have a Community Recreation Center, we must utilize the schools for the majority of our programs. Programs held in schools will be cancelled in the event of school evening activities or school closings due to vacation or inclement weather.

All activities, dates, locations and fees are subject to change. This document is intended for use as a general guide to activities available throughout the year. ADAPTIVE FITNESS CLASSES

Eligibility: Boys & girls with special needs in Grades 1-12; Southington residents only
Occurs: Monday evenings (6 classes per session); occurrences vary based on space availability
Location: DePaolo Middle School
Registration: Ongoing at the Recreation office prior to 1st class
Fee: \$55.00 per child

ARTS & CRAFTS CLASSES

Eligibility: Individuals with special needs; no age or residency requirements; all participants must be accompanied by an adult
Occurs: Thursday evenings (8 classes), October-May
Location: Derynoski Elementary School
Registration: Ongoing at the Recreation office prior to 1st class
Fee: \$120.00 per person

BALLROOM, LATIN & SWING DANCE LESSONS

Lessons are taught at both beginner and intermediate levels.

Eligibility: Adult men & women (18+); couples only (no singles); no residency requirements
Occurs: Wednesday evenings (8 classes per session), Spring (Mar-May) & Fall (Oct-Nov)
Location: Plantsville Elementary School
Registration: Ongoing at the Recreation office prior to 1st class
Fee: \$60.00 per couple

BASEBALL – LITTLE LEAGUE (FALL)

Southington South Baseball League coordinates this program, which is open to children from the entire town (participation is not split into North, South & West based on home address as the Spring program is).

Eligibility: Boys & girls ages 6-17; Southington residents only

Registration: July, in person on scheduled dates & by mail
Fee: Varies – to be set by the league

BASEBALL – LITTLE LEAGUE (SPRING)

Fee: Varies – to be set by the league

Eligibility: Southington residents/landowners only; must have valid/current year DEEP archery license
Occurs: Monday-Saturday, September 15 through December 30 (dates determined annually by DEEP)
Location: Crescent Lake
Registration: Weekly permits required; must present proof of residency (driver’s license) or copy of recent tax bill (for non-resident taxpayers) and current year archery license. Permits must be obtained in advance at the Recreation office during regular business hours.
Fee: None
