## **ADAPTIVE FITNESS CLASSES**

Eligibility: Boys & girls with special needs in Grades 1-12; Southington residents only  
Occurs: Monday evenings (5 classes per session); occurrences vary based on space availability  
Location: DePaolo Middle School  
Registration: Ongoing at the Recreation office prior to 1<sup>st</sup> class  
Fee: \$55.00 per child

## **ARTS & CRAFTS CLASSES**

Eligibility: Individuals with special needs; no age or residency requirements; all participants must be accompanied by an adult  
Occurs: Thursday evenings (8 classes), October-May  
Location: Derynoski Elementary School  
Registration: Ongoing at the Recreation office prior to 1<sup>st</sup> class  
Fee: \$80.00 per person

## **BALLROOM, LATIN & SWING DANCE LESSONS**

Registration: January-February, in person on scheduled dates and by mail  
Fee: Varies – to be set by the leagues

Registration: October-December, by mail or in person at the Recreation office  
Fee: \$425.00 per team; additional \$50.00 per out-of-town player (max. 3)

Eligibility: Southington residents/landowners only; must have valid/current year DEEP archery license  
Occurs: Monday-Saturday, September 15 through December 30 (dates determined annually by DEEP)  
Location: Crescent Lake  
Registration: Weekly permits required; must present proof of residency (driver’s license) or copy of recent tax bill (for non-resident taxpayers) and current year archery license. Permits must be obtained in advance at the Recreation office during regular business hours.  
Fee: None
